The country's largest festival of learning takes place during Adult Learners' Week (alw). A wide variety of taster courses and classes will be provided. Square Dancing can be a part of that provision. You could run a taster class or course. You may be able to run an open evening at your club as your taster course but check beforehand. For this you may consider a "Strictly Fun Dance" evening as described by Gene Turner elsewhere in this magazine.

You provide the venue and the caller and you will be given lots of free advertising. The event is given a great deal of national publicity on TV, radio and in the press. Your class will be included in a colourful brochure and can be uploaded on to the alw's website. Your local organiser will also give you help and advice and may help you find a venue.
